

Question: Pastor would you explain why we worship on Sunday instead of Saturday the original Sabbath day?

Answer: We follow the New Testament day of worship found in several scriptures Mark 28:1, Mark 16:2,9; Luke 24:1; John 20:1,19; Acts 20:7; 1 Cor 16:2. The Jews were under the law and worshipped as commanded by Jehovah in the Old Testament. Under the New Testament we celebrate the Sabbath on the day Jesus Christ rose from the grave. That's why we call Sunday, Resurrection Sunday. But note also that the Sabbath day is still Saturday, but we are not under the law we are under grace and have chosen to worship on the first day of the week in honor of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
