I would like to inform you of the activities that we have in store for the Warriors. You may have heard about the "I Challenge" program that was kicked off in late January. In which we have been challenging them with lessons from the bible and laying out "Ten" challenging items that will allow them to express their love for Jesus Christ and family.
